Classes operate Monday through Friday with five levels of classes:

Elementary Levels: Students range from toddlers to grade 6 and they ordinarily have regular instruction

Elementary Level I - for toddlers and first-graders. This is their first interaction with the English language

Elementary Level II – for students in the 2nd and 3rd grades. At this level, students already study English.

Elementary Level III - for students grades 4 to 6.

Adult Levels: Student ages range from youths to retired adults. Their English knowledge ranges from Beginner to Advanced.

Adult Level I – for Beginner-level students. These classes are the first introduction of the language.

Adult Level II - Intermediate. Students have some knowledge of English. At the completion of this level, students can understand and communicate in English.

Adult Level III – Advanced classes will be available in the future.
